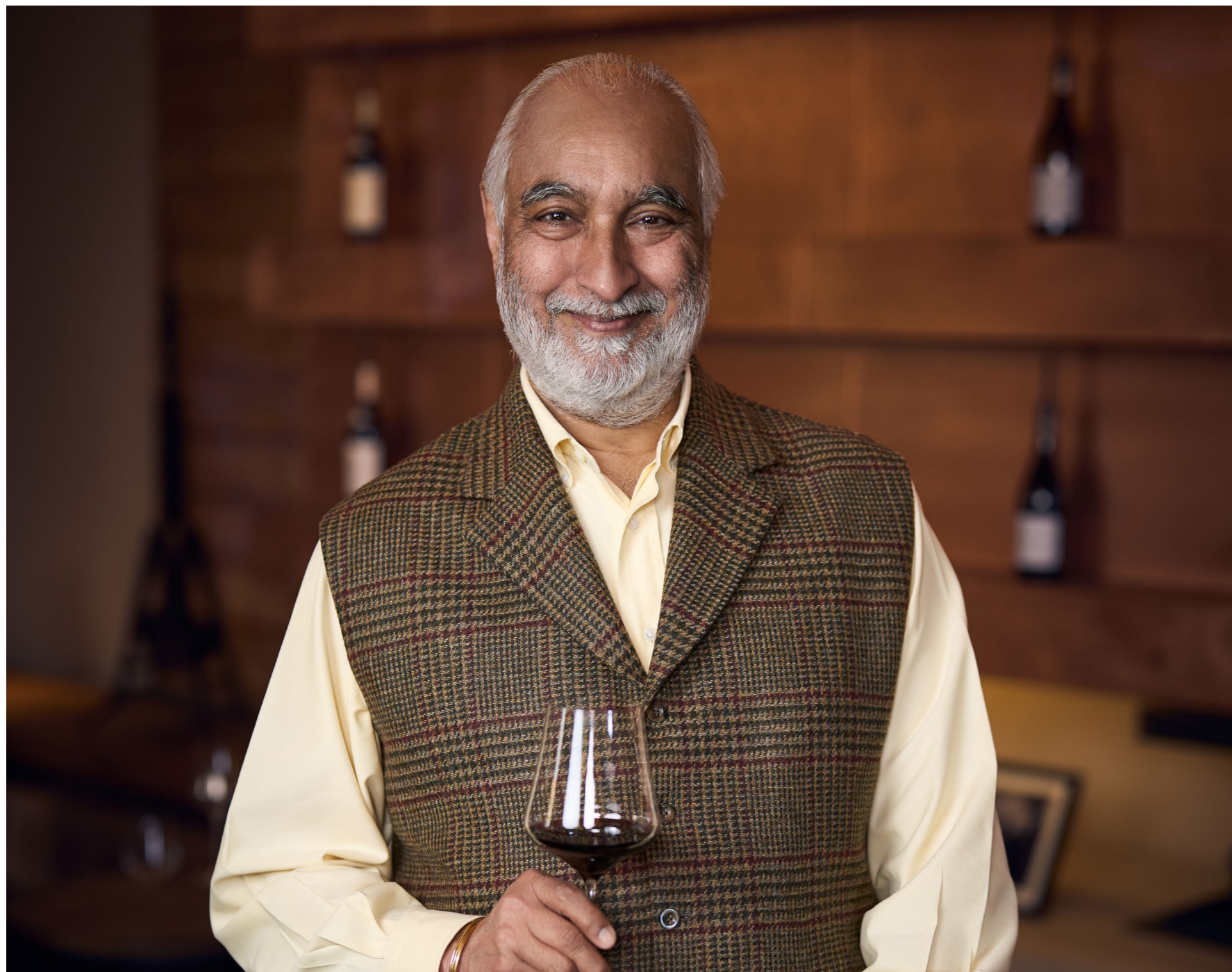

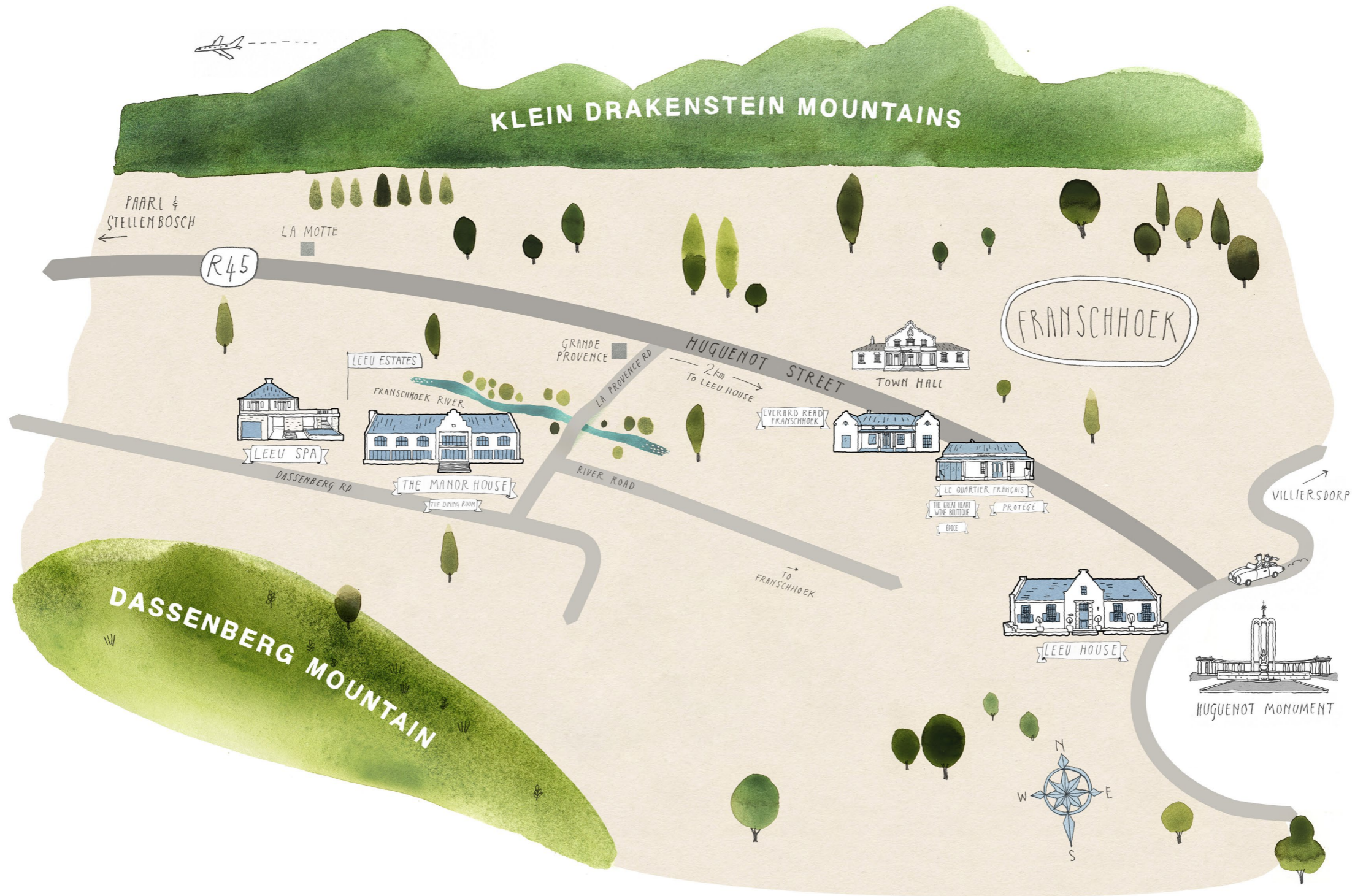
The Leeu Collection's hospitality portfolio comprises one five-star premium and two five-star boutique properties in South Africa's winelands: Leeu Estates, a five-star premium 24-room country house and boutique winery in the Franschhoek valley; Leeu House, an exclusive 12-room and suite hotel in the heart of Franschhoek village; and Le Quartier Français, a romantic 25-room hotel with a standalone cottage, also located in the village. The first acquisition outside of South Africa was Linthwaite House, a 36-room country retreat overlooking Windermere in England's scenic Lake District; followed by Collegio alla Querce, a luxury 83-room hotel and pristine gardens in Florence, Italy. Both the historic centre of Florence and the Lake District are UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

Leeu Collection has welcomed top chefs and their restaurants into our properties, to enhance the guest experience. The award-winning La Colombe team offers tantalising dining experiences at La Petite Colombe on Leeu Estates; Protégé and Epice are at Le Quartier Français. The Dining Room on Leeu Estates, caters to guests staying at any of our Leeu Collection properties, serving an avant-garde approach to a list of favourite novelty dishes. Henrock is overseen by acclaimed Michelin Star Chef Simon Rogan MBE at Linthwaite House, and our resident chefs guarantee that visitors can enjoy inventive all-day dining and bar snacks in The Bar & Conservatory.

In partnership with the talented husband-and-wife wine-maker team behind the esteemed Mullineux wines produced on Roundstone Farm in the Swartland wine region and the Leeu Passant wines on Leeu Estates in Franschhoek, Mullineux & Leeu Family Wines offers engaging tastings at The Wine Studio on Leeu Estates and The Great Heart wines (a Mullineux staff empowerment programme) at The Wine Boutique housed at Le Quartier Français.

Everard Read, the oldest commercial art gallery on the African continent, was established in 1913. Specialists in contemporary art from South Africa and the diaspora, their sixth gallery, Everard Read Franschhoek, is adjacent to Le Quartier Français. The gallery at Leeu Estates augments the existing gallery in the high street of Franschhoek, showing monumental sculptures in the breathtaking fynbos and vineyards, as well as exhibiting important works by our artists in the purpose-built gallery on site.

Leeu Estates' rich Cape Dutch architectural heritage has been meticulously restored, artfully blending old and new.

The exceptional interiors of the 19th-century Manor House are matched by the equally spectacular surrounding mountain panoramas. This 24-roomed boutique hotel boasts various luxury accommodation options that are equipped with the latest technology and amenities.

Leeu Collection's founder, Analjit Singh (aka BAS), is a partner in Mullineux & Leeu Family Wines with Chris and Andrea Mullineux, the talented husband-and-wife winemaker team behind the outstanding Mullineux wines produced on Roundstone Farm in the Swartland wine region and the Leeu Passant Wines on Leeu Estates in Franschoek.

The Wine Studio on Leeu Estates offers three tutored tastings: Mullineux Signature tasting (one complimentary tasting per guest when staying at Leeu Estates), Mullineux Single Terroir tasting, and Leeu Passant tastings.

Patrons at any of our partnered restaurants within the Leeu Collection have the opportunity to enjoy a selection of these wines that feature on the wine lists.







INDABA THE MEETING PLACE

Indaba - The Meeting Place at Leeu Estates is a refined, light-filled space for gatherings and ideas available for all in-house Leeu Collection guests. The light-filled space, with its open roof trusses, tall windows, timber floors and natural finishes, perfectly complements the collection of art and sculptures.

The well-appointed venue can accommodate up to 60 guests (cocktail) both inside and on the terrace, overlooking the beautiful valley and mountain landscape, for a variety of private exhibitions and product launches.

Press briefings, seminars, business meetings and management think tank sessions for up to 22 guests can be accommodated in the boardroom, 28 guests in the schoolroom or U-shaped seating areas. Cinema seating can accommodate up to 60 guests. Indaba, which is 140 square meters (1 510 square feet) and has its own lift, provides audio and video conferencing equipment, a 203-centimetre (80-inch) television screen and high-speed Wi-Fi. Catering for Indaba is done by The Dining Room culinary team.

A serene, contemporary wellness space designed to restore both body and mind. Tailored treatments, inspired by Africa's rich heritage, are delivered by skilled therapists in a peaceful atmosphere.

Leeu Spa offers four treatment rooms, along with separate changing areas and steam rooms for male and female guests. The tranquil plunge pool overlooks a lily pond, creating a quiet pause between treatments and guests are invited to enjoy the relaxation lounge pre and post treatments.

HENROCK

Henrock is an informal and relaxed restaurant from chef and restaurateur Simon Rogan MBE, set within Linthwaite House in the fells above Windermere.

The team has created a set menu and a tasting menu, both stay true to Simon Rogan's farm-to-table ethos and deep-rooted respect for natural ingredients. Much of the produce comes from Simon's farm, known as Our Farm, located just a few miles away in the Cartmel Valley, whilst flavours and techniques are inspired by his travels to his international restaurants in Hong Kong, Malta and Phuket.

Offering all the pleasures of a refined country home, Collegio alla Querce balances the sophistication of Florence with the gentle rhythm of Tuscany in characteristic Italian style.

Perched on a hillside, the hotel provides breathtaking views of Florence's architectural wonders and the rolling Tuscan countryside. The historic property, originally a cultural institution and beloved boarding school dating back to the 16th century, has been thoughtfully reimaged to honour its storied past while embracing contemporary elegance.

A 5-star luxury urban retreat, Collegio alla Querce features 83 guest rooms and suites across three historic buildings, an original chapel and theatre, a light-filled conservatory, and extensive lobbies and public areas. 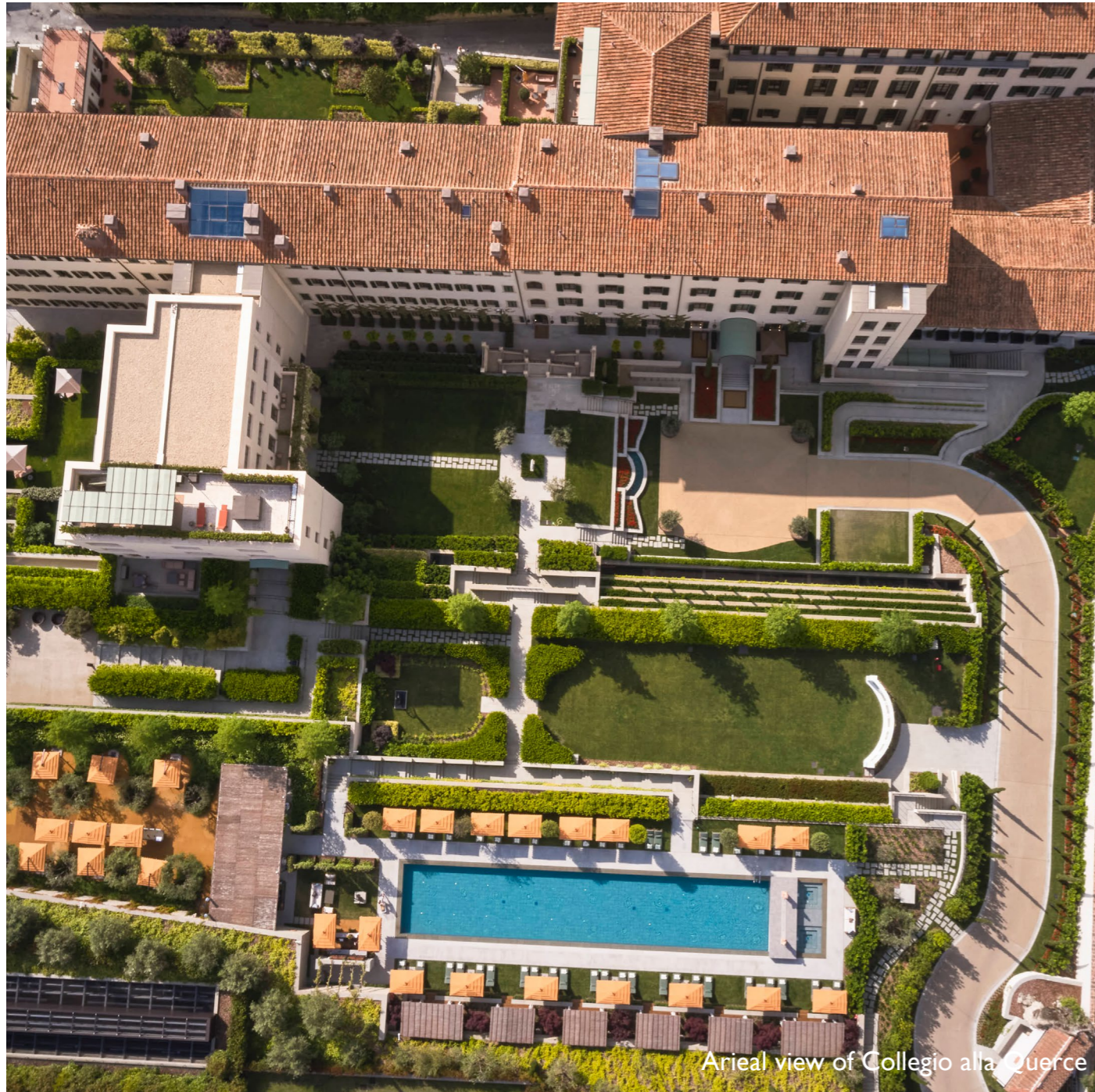

FARMTOTABLE

Leeu Collection is committed to sustainable, locally sourced produce, ensuring that fresh, natural ingredients are at the heart of its culinary experiences. Cuisine showcasing the finest locally sourced, organic, and ethically farmed produce is prepared at the various restaurants across the Leeu Collection properties. All meat is carefully sourced from GMO-free, pasture-reared animals, and all chicken is free-range. Fish is caught locally by individual fishermen who have their own boats, while vegetables are sourced as locally as possible from farms in and around the area where the hotels are situated.

At Leeu Estates, Leeu House, and Le Quartier Français in Franschhoek, the Leeu Locally Grown initiative ensures that the freshest ingredients are cultivated right on the estate. In August 2019, under the guidance of Christine Stevens, a series of vegetable, herb, and fruit gardens were planted to supply the restaurants, hotels, and spa. These crops are grown following natural farming principles - no pesticides or herbicides are used - ensuring the finest, tastiest produce is available for the chefs.

Carefully selected heirloom seeds have been sourced and planted in the gardens and the enclosed temperature-controlled tunnel. Whether it be strawberries, heritage tomatoes, or baskets of herbs, each morning's harvest is sent immediately to the kitchens to feature in the daily dishes. Seeds from the most popular vegetables are saved for future seasons, and all waste is composted to maintain sustainability.

At Linthwaite House, sustainability and seasonality remain at the forefront. The Our Farm initiative supplies Henrock as well as The Bar & Conservatory with freshly harvested vegetables, fruit, and herbs grown using natural farming techniques. This ensures that only the freshest, ethically farmed produce makes its way into the dishes.
