## HOTEL OVERVIEW

## CLIMATE

The Lake District has a generally mild maritime climate characterised by ample rainfall. Winters are wet with some snow and summers are relatively dry by comparison (average temperatures range from 0°C/32°F in January to 19°C/66°F in July).

**WHAT TO PACK** Layering is the way to go as the weather is unpredictable and can change rapidly in both summer and winter. Comfortable, sturdy shoes, a fleece and a waterproof jacket are recommended if you plan to go walking. Summer: Cool, light clothing, along with a sun hat, sunscreen, sunglasses and at least one warm sweater as the weather is changeable. Light jackets or jerseys are recommended for the evenings. Winter: Woollens and a warm coat for outdoors.

## LAKE DISTRICT

The Lake District, which is also known as The Lakes, is a mountainous region in the county of Cumbria in the northwest of England. A UNESCO World Heritage Site and a popular holiday destination, with its lakes, forests and fells (hills or mountains) providing a platform for many outdoor activities, the area is famous for its spectacular scenery. The Lake District offers an array of interesting places to visit too, as it is home to many magnificent historic houses and gardens. A literature trail offers a fascinating glimpse into the lives of writers and artists, including poet William Wordsworth and children's book author Beatrix Potter.

Henrock at Linthwaite House is overseen by Michelin-starred chef Simon Rogan, who has five restaurants in the UK and holds four Michelin stars between them. Henrock, with its stunning views over Linthwaite's immaculately landscaped gardens, showcases natural, perfectly seasonal ingredients in a relaxed and elegant setting. The restaurant is named after Hen Holme (a rocky outcrop protruding from Windermere that is often visible from the terrace of Linthwaite House).

Breakfast is from 07h30 to 10h30, dinner from 18h00 to 21h30 and Sunday lunch from 12h00 to 15h00.

The Bar & Conservatory at Linthwaite House serves craft cocktails, an all-day dining menu and a selection of afternoon teas. Opening hours are from 11h00 until 23h00 (kitchen opens at 12h00 and closes at 21h30).

The culinary offerings at Linthwaite House's sister properties in the scenic South African Winelands live up to the Franschoek valley's reputation as one of the world's great food and wine destinations. La Colombe, the award-winning and world-renowned restaurant based in Constantia, one of the oldest winemaking regions of South Africa, has established a sister restaurant at Leeu Estate, run by the talented La Petite Colombe team, which is also home to Le chene. Le chene steers an accomplished culinary team to serve French-inspired dishes made from local produce, honouring Franschoek's history with both the name and concept of this unique dining experience.

Protégé is a casual-style eatery at Le Quartier Français under the guidance of celebrity chef Scot Kirton. Visitors looking for an informal eatery now have the perfect venue in Protégé, featuring stylish casual fare. Le Quartier Français is also home to Epice; the flavour-packed menu is inspired by the team's culinary expedition to India, as well as memories of travels through Spain, Japan, Mexico, Denmark and the US. And presented in a home-cooking-style with a refined edge.
