HOTEL OVERVIEW

This luxurious 36-room boutique hotel is located in the heart of England's Lake District a UNESCO world heritage site, and set in 14 acres (5.7 hectares) of established gardens and well-maintained private woodland grounds. Linthwaite House, which is on a hilltop overlooking Windermere, is the perfect base from which to explore the scenic surroundings.

CLIMATE

The Lake District has a generally mild maritime climate characterised by ample rainfall. Winters are wet with some snow and summers are relatively dry by comparison (average temperatures range from 0°C/32°F in January to 19°C/66°F in July). WHAT TO PACK Layering is the way to go as the weather is unpredictable and can change rapidly in both summer and winter. Comfortable, sturdy shoes, a fleece and a waterproof jacket are recommended if you plan to go walking. Summer: Cool, light clothing, along with a sun hat, sunscreen, sunglasses and at least one warm sweater as the weather is changeable. Light jackets or jerseys are recommended for the evenings. Winter, woollens, and a warm coat for outdoors.

LAKE DISTRICT

The Lake District, which is also known as The Lakes, is a mountainous region in the county of Cumbria in the northwest of England. A UNESCO World Heritage Site and a popular holiday destination, with its lakes, forests and fells (hills or mountains) providing a platform for many outdoor activities, the area is famous for its spectacular scenery. The Lake District offers an array of interesting places to visit too, as it is home to many magnificent historic houses and gardens. A literature trail offers a fascinating glimpse into the lives of writers and artists, including poet William Wordsworth and children's book author Beatrix Potter.

DINING

Henrock at Linthwaite House is overseen by Michelin-starred chef Simon Rogan, who has five restaurants in the UK and holds four Michelin stars between them. Henrock, with its stunning views over Linthwaite's immaculately landscaped gardens, showcases natural, perfectly seasonal ingredients in a relaxed and elegant setting. The restaurant is named after Hen Holme (a rocky outcrop protruding from Windermere that is often visible from the terrace of Linthwaite House).

Dinner is served from 18h00 to 21h30 by the Simon Rogan team, with Linthwaite House offering breakfast between 07h30 and 10h20. The Bar & Conservatory at Linthwaite House serves craft cocktails and nibbles.

The culinary offerings at Linthwaite House's sister properties in the scenic South African Winelands live up to the Franschhoek valley's reputation as one of the world's great food and wine destinations. La Colombe, the award-winning and world-renowned restaurant based in Constantia, one of the oldest winemaking regions of South Africa, has established a sister restaurant at Leeu Estates, run by the talented La Petite Colombe team. Visitors to the epicurean valley of Franschhoek can now look forward to experiencing the same level of service excellence and exquisite cuisine that put La Colombe on the map. The Dining Room on Leeu Estates offers residents the option of never having to leave the property, if they so desire. With comprehensive menu offerings and options to personally tailor your dining experiences (even the little ones are catered for exclusively), leisurely meals and fine vintages within the Mullineux and Leeu Family Wines and Great Heart Wines range from the cellar can be enjoyed in the conservatory, the deck and bar.


