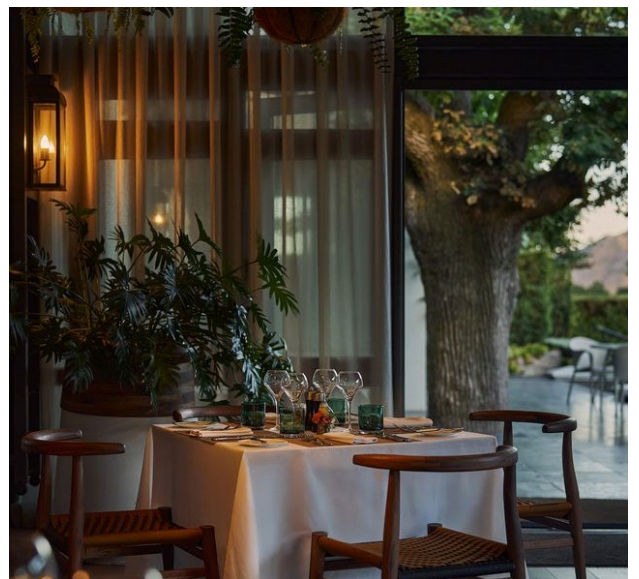

Both restaurants are led by Chef-Proprietor Ryan Shell. [Le Coin Français](#) pays homage to the region's heritage, artistry, and wine culture through its fusion of cutting-edge culinary techniques and timeless French elegance. At [Chefs Warehouse](#) – Maison, flavour boundaries are pushed with surprising and delightful combinations. [Arkeste](#) at Chamonix Wine Farm blends relaxed refinement, guided by renowned chef Ashwin Johannes, who revisits classics and introduces new creations using seasonal, locally sourced ingredients. Lastly, [Orangerie](#) at Le Lude offers a sumptuous à la carte menu and delightful Morning and Afternoon Teas, creating a diverse culinary journey in this South African town. Stellenbosch

[Cavalli](#) restaurant (42 kilometres away), overlooking a serene dam set against the backdrop of the Helderberg Mountain range, is a must-visit dining destination in the Cape Winelands. [VUUR](#) Restaurant is an intimate, reservation-only fine dining restaurant. Led by chef-owner Shaun Scrooby, the restaurant is centred around open-fire cooking, where every dish is prepared over wood flames, embers, or smoke to highlight the natural flavours of locally sourced South African ingredients. In the heart of the historic town's old Post Office, [Post and Pepper](#) offers playful and refined cooking with reimagined classics and twists on traditional favourites.

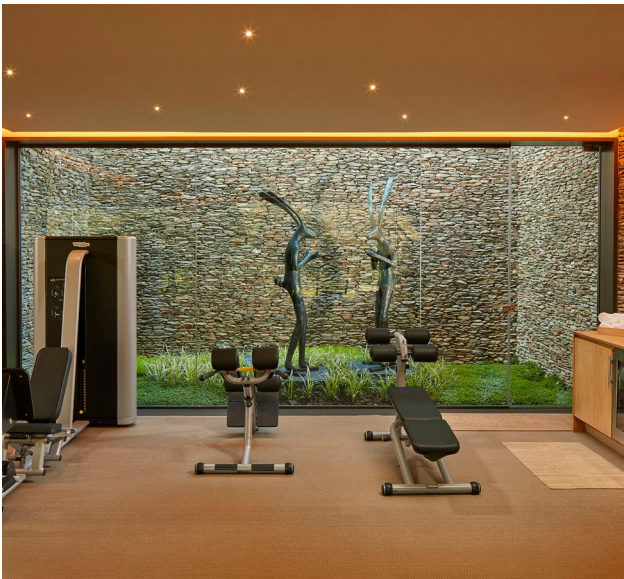

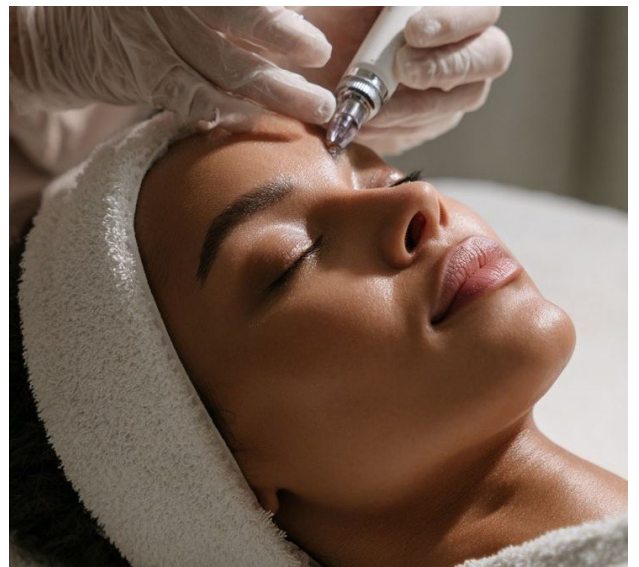

[Paserene](#) stands out with meticulous artistry in both labels and wines, tailored for the refined palate. [Atlas Swift](#) explores the multisensory aspect of wine, focusing on Chardonnays from different regions and offering diverse expressions. [Klein Goederust](#), under Siguqa family ownership since 2019, invites you to taste in their historic 1905 building. [GlenWood's](#) success story began in 1984, boasting Platter 5-star Chardonnay and gourmet sushi pairings on a scenic oak-tree terrace. [Boekenhoutskloof](#), established in 1776, cherishes indigenous Cape Beech trees and offers an array of carefully crafted wines.

Along the R45

On the outskirts of Franschhoek, [Plaisir Wine Estate](#), located a short 17 kilometres from the town centre, offers a refined experience with exceptional wines, delightful food pairings, and panoramic views of the Simonsberg Mountains. Its historic 1823 barn serves as a charming tasting room. About 18 kilometres from Franschhoek, [Vrede en Lust](#) is nestled within a natural amphitheatre shaped by the cliffs of the Simonsberg Mountains, carrying a rich history dating back to the arrival of the French Huguenots in 1688. Equally distant, the [Rupert & Rothschild](#) tasting centre adjoins the serene outdoors and the restaurant, exuding elegance with French oak furniture and art from the Rupert Museum, offering a diverse array of wines. [Noble Hill](#), situated 20 kilometres from Franschhoek, welcomes guests to enjoy wine tastings on the shaded terrace under a picturesque willow tree, with knowledgeable staff assisting in selecting the perfect wine complemented by locally sourced cheese pairings.

Banghoek Valley (Helshoogte Pass)

Embark on an exploration of Stellenbosch's renowned Banghoek Valley, housing a collection of exceptional wine farms. Just 23 kilometres from Franschhoek, the lovingly restored [Bartiney](#) wine farm beckons with its double-aspect space adorned with native fynbos plants and a splendid chandelier crafted from aged vines. Unwind on the terrace while taking in unparalleled panoramic views stretching across the valley and Simonsberg. Among these wineries, [Tokara](#), also located 23 kilometres from Franschhoek, distinguishes itself as an all-encompassing destination for wine and culinary enthusiasts. Here, expert-guided wine tastings and an upscale restaurant featuring locally inspired cuisine and award-winning wines await visitors. The sculpture garden and picturesque vineyards further enhance the experience, making it an ideal indulgence for couples, families, and solo travellers. Just a short distance away, 24 kilometres from Franschhoek, you'll discover [Delaire Graff Estate](#) nestled in the heart of the Winelands, offering a unique wine tasting experience complemented by breathtaking views of Simonsberg Mountain. To conclude this wine-rich journey, [Oldenburg Vineyards](#) welcomes wine enthusiasts to its Tasting Room, providing an opportunity to immerse in the natural beauty of the mountain amphitheatre, the vineyards on Rondekop, and the stories and activities behind the wine. The belief at Oldenburg Vineyards is that sharing wine stories truly brings the experience to life.

Fine water tastings are partly inspired by wine tastings, but they also introduce their own unique approach. Each fine water tells the story of its place of origin, from ancient glaciers to volcanic rock, and is naturally imbued with minerals that create a distinct flavour of terroir in every drop.

Stellenbosch

For designated drivers and non-alcoholic bubbly drinkers, enjoy the tasting options and food pairings at [J.C. Le Roux](#) (39 kilometres away). These pairing options include: a non-alcoholic sparkling wine and nougat experience; non-alcoholic bubbly and artisan chocolate indulgence; non-alcoholic bubbly and cheesecake pairing; a non-alcoholic sparkling wine and biltong pairing and lastly a non-alcoholic bubbly and pizza pairing. Children can also enjoy their own juice and pizza pairing. J.C. Le Roux is South Africa's first dedicated sparkling wine cellar. Visit [Blaauwklippen's](#) market (35 kilometres away) over the weekend, with breathtaking scenery of the Cape Dutch architecture. They also offer a [Kids Pizza Pairing](#) to keep the little ones entertained during your visit.

Afternoon Teas in the Winelands

Enjoy an afternoon of “[Tranquillity and Tea](#)” at La Residence, paired with mouthwatering savoury delights and sweet treats ranging from macarons to scones. Served at the Bistro, a [High Tea](#) at [La Paris Estate](#), 27 kilometres away) it is a delicious way to spend your day. Featuring a curated mix of sweet and savoury bites, paired with your choice of house teas, coffee, gin, whiskey, etc. The High Tea experience also has [gluten-free](#) and [vegan](#) options, along with “[Whiskey Lovers](#)’ High Tea. A Timeless Afternoon Tea is waiting for you at [Lanzerac's Manor Kitchen](#) (30 kilometres away). Here you can enjoy a delectable feast with re-imagined canapes and an assortment of savoury and sweet plates. Upgrade this memorable experience to include bottomless Cap Classique.

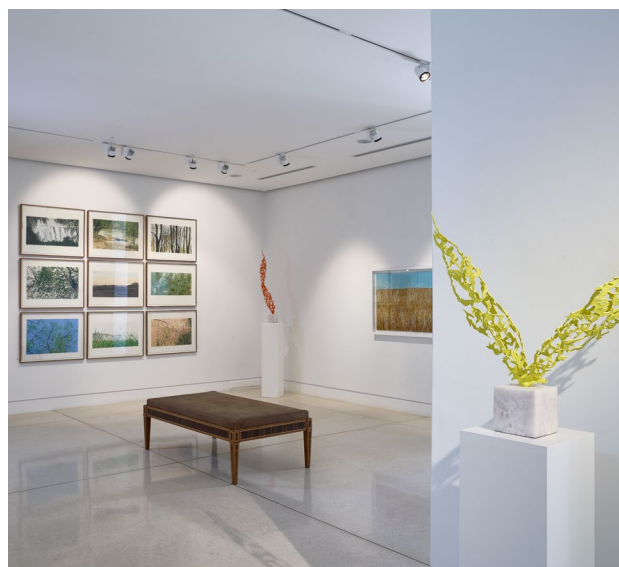
EVERARD READ GALLERIES

There are two [Everard Read galleries in Franschhoek](#): one adjacent to Le Quartier Français and the other at Leeu Estates on the flagship property of Leeu Collection. These galleries showcase contemporary art year-round through solo and group exhibitions.

Everard Read at Leeu Estates, opened in November 2020, combines a gallery and sculpture park, emphasising monumental sculptures set amid stunning fynbos and vineyards, and showcasing significant works in its purpose-built gallery.

In collaboration with Joanne Lefson, she created remarkable artworks that highlight the connections among food systems, animals, and climate change. Her legacy continues to inspire. [EBONY/CURATED](#), a leading South African gallery spanning three locations, two of which are in Franschhoek, highlights contemporary and notable modern artworks.

SCULPTURE GARDEN TOURS

Stellenbosch

Explore the lush and inspiring gardens of the Cape Winelands. A short 16 kilometres from Franschhoek, [Boschendal](#) offers guided walking tours that provide insights into the farm's history, regenerative farming practices, and sustainable gardening. These tours also offer opportunities for harvesting herbs and fruit, allowing you to immerse yourself in the beauty of the Cape Winelands. Just 21 kilometres from Franschhoek, [Babylonstoren's](#) garden, inspired by Cape Town's historic Company's Gardengarden, inspired by Cape Town's historic Company's Garden, is central to the farm's heritage and provides fresh produce. Located 37 kilometres from Franschhoek, The [Dylan Lewis Sculpture Garden](#) on Stellenbosch Mountain spans seven hectares, offering expansive vistas, serene groves, and sculptures that express the untamed wilderness within the human psyche.
