EBONY/CURATED, a leading South African gallery spanning three locations, two of which are in Franschhoek, highlights contemporary and notable modern artworks.

MUSEUMS

Begin your journey at the <u>Huguenot Memorial Museum</u>, paying homage to the 17th-century French Huguenots and narrating their story within the broader context of global refugees. The museum's galleries delve into Huguenot history, while an annex hosts exhibitions on Franschhoek, Fynbos, Khoisan, and Huguenot families. Just 12 km from Franschhoek's village center, automotive enthusiasts will discover the must-visit <u>Franschhoek Motor Museum</u>, which houses over a century of automotive history in a collection exceeding 220 vehicles. Lastly, delve into the captivating world of perfumery at the <u>South African Perfume Museum</u>, located just a stone's throw from the Huguenot Memorial Museum. Antique treasures, some dating back to Roman times, and cutting-edge exhibitions await, all deeply rooted in the Kumanov family's centuries-long heritage as perfume importers and manufacturers. Experience the art of perfumery with Perfume Prive Workshop's expert-guided creation of personalized, high-quality signature scents. Explore these cultural gems in Franschhoek.

WINE TASTING

Paserene stands out with meticulous artistry in both labels and wines, tailored for the refined palate. Atlas Swift explores the multisensory aspect of wine, focusing on Chardonnays from different regions, offering diverse expressions. Klein Goederust, under Siguqa family ownership since 2019, invites you to taste in their historic 1905 building. GlenWood's success story began in 1984, boasting Platter 5-star Chardonnay and gourmet sushi pairings in a scenic oak tree terrace. Boekenhoutskloof, established in 1776, cherishes indigenous Cape Beech trees and offers an array of carefully crafted wines.



CAP CLASSIQUE WINERIES

Embark on a sparkling journey through the heart of Franschhoek, where the world of bubbly beckons with open arms. Experience the joy of bubbly with Colmant, tailor-making The Bubbly Experience for passionate enthusiasts. Delve into the captivating worlds of Cap Classique and Champagne, expanding your knowledge through unique opportunities. Choose from various packages, including sabrage experiences, cellar tours, and in-depth tastings with their winemaker. The historical backdrop of Haute Cabriere dates back to 1694 when Pierre Jourdan was granted land in Olifantshoek, now Franschhoek, naming it Cabrière. In the early 1980s, Achim von Arnim acquired a portion of this land, focused on producing Champagne-style wines. Enjoy guided cellar tours with sabrage demonstrations and delightful wine tastings, a remarkable 90-minute experience. Le Lude's tasting room combines tasteful and stylish design inspired by contemporary French aesthetics. Using light and space, it creates an inviting atmosphere with soft green paneling. Elevate your tasting experience with concise canapé menus and options for morning and afternoon tea.

MICROBREWERIES

In the heart of Franschhoek, <u>Tuk Tuk Microbrewery</u>, the sole microbrewery along the main road, invites both locals and visitors to "park off for a pint" and delight in exceptional beers and delectable food. This beloved landmark offers a truly distinctive and laid-back dining experience. Just 3km from town on the R45 Main Road, <u>Hey Joe's Brewing Co.</u>, a Belgian-inspired Abbey-style brewery, proudly adheres to artisanal beer brewing. Their beer is crafted in a 1961 copper brewhouse imported from Belgium, accompanied by a curated menu drawing inspiration from Belgian cuisine and designed to cater to vegetarians, vegans, and children. Situated 8km from the village centre, the <u>Franschhoek Beer Company</u> boasts picturesque oak trees, rolling lawns, a tasting room with breathtaking views of the brewery, and the town's finest burgers. Their world-class beer is meticulously handcrafted on-site, using pristine mountain spring waters and top-quality imported hops and malt, ensuring an unparalleled beer experience.

Located 23 kilometres from Leeu Estates, Paarl Golf Club on Boschenmeer Estate, nestled in the picturesque Paarl-Franschhoek valley, boasts a warm tradition of hospitality and meticulously maintained fairways set against a backdrop of mountains and vineyards. A short 38 kilometres from Leeu Estates, De Zalze Golf Course, situated within the De Zalze Winelands Golf Estate, offers a delightful mix of parkland and tree-lined holes along the Blaauwklippen River, providing a memorable golfing adventure for all skill levels. Just 54 kilometres from Leeu Estates, Erinvale offers a golfing experience surrounded by majestic mountains, with two distinctive nine-hole sections that offer varying landscapes and breathtaking views. Explore the beauty of the South African winelands while teeing off on these exceptional courses.

GARDEN / SCULPTURE TOURS

Explore the lush and inspiring gardens of the Cape Winelands. A short 16 kilometres from Franschhoek, <u>Boschendal</u> offers guided walking tours that provide insights into the farm's history, regenerative farming practices, and sustainable gardening. These tours also offer opportunities for herb and fruit harvesting, allowing you to immerse yourself in the beauty of the Cape Winelands. Just 21 kilometres from Franschhoek, <u>Babylonstoren's</u> garden, inspired by Cape Town's historic Company's Garden, is essential to the farm's heritage and provides fresh produce. Located 37 kilometres from Franschhoek, The <u>Dylan Lewis Sculpture Garden</u> on Stellenbosch Mountain spans seven hectares, offering expansive vistas, serene groves, and sculptures that express the untamed wilderness within the human psyche.

ADVENTURE / OUTDOOR / ACTIVITIES

Explore the magnificent beauty of the Cape Winelands and the Peninsula, Table Mountain, or seasonal whale watching like never before. Quick flips, full or half-day tours, airport transfers, and extreme experiences are all available in a helicopter that seats four passengers. Wine Valley Horse Trails, located just 18 kilometres from Franschhoek on the Rhebokskloof Wine Estate in Paarl, South Africa, now offers Wine Valley Quad Bike Trails. These quad bikes provide guests with the same scenic views and nature experience as horse riders. The guided quad bike excursions range from half-hour to two-hour trails and include a fun obstacle course amidst the forest for novice riders to practice and refine their skills, guided by experienced professionals.

WINE TASTING

On the outskirts of Franschhoek, <u>Plaisir Wine Estate</u>, located a short 17 kilometres from the town centre, offers a refined experience with exceptional wines, delightful food pairings, and panoramic views of the Simonsberg Mountain. Their historic 1823 barn serves as a charming tasting room. A bit further, at 18 kilometres from Franschhoek, <u>Vrede en Lust</u> is nestled within a natural amphitheatre shaped by the cliffs of the Simonsberg Mountain, carrying a rich history dating back to the arrival of the French Huguenots in 1688. Equally distant, the <u>Rupert & Rothschild</u> tasting centre adjoins the serene outdoors and the restaurant, exuding elegance with French oak furniture and art from the Rupert Museum, offering a diverse array of wines. <u>Noble Hill</u>, situated 20 kilometres from Franschhoek, welcomes guests to enjoy wine tastings on the shaded terrace under a picturesque willow tree, with a knowledgeable staff assisting in selecting the perfect wine complemented by locally sourced cheese pairings.

Embark on an exploration of Stellenbosch's renowned Banghoek Valley, housing a collection of exceptional wine farms. Just 23 kilometres from Franschhoek, the lovingly restored Bartinney wine farm beckons with its double-aspect space adorned with native fynbos plants and a splendid chandelier crafted from aged vines. Unwind on the terrace while taking in unparalleled panoramic views stretching across the valley and Simonsberg. Among these wineries, Tokara, also situated 23 kilometres from Franschhoek, distinguishes itself as an all-encompassing destination for wine and culinary enthusiasts. Here, expert-guided wine tastings, an upscale restaurant featuring locally inspired cuisine and award-winning wines, await visitors. The sculpture garden and picturesque vineyards further enhance the experience, making it an ideal indulgence for couples, families, and solo travellers. Just a short distance away, 24 kilometres from Franschhoek, you'll discover Delaire Graff Estate nestled in the heart of the Winelands, offering a unique wine tasting experience complemented by breathtaking views of Simonsberg Mountain. To conclude this wine-rich journey, Oldenburg Vineyards welcomes wine enthusiasts to its Tasting Room, providing an opportunity to immerse in the natural beauty of the mountain amphitheatre, the vineyards on Rondekop, and the stories and activities behind the wine. The belief at Oldenburg Vineyards is that sharing wine stories truly brings the experience to life.
